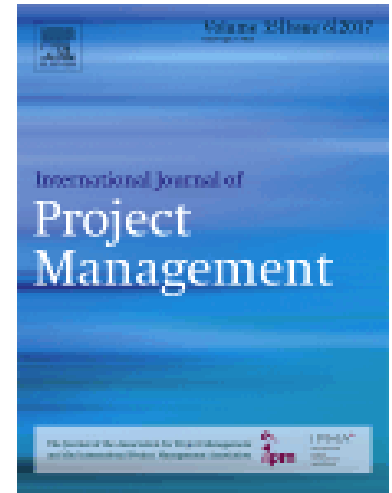

IJPM Scope

- Publish leading edge innovative research that significantly advances the field of project management and organizing
 - Managing projects, programs and portfolios, project-based/oriented organizations, project networks, and project-oriented societies.
 - Often related to perspectives as organizational behavior, HRM, strategy, change, innovation, etc
 - Be cautious with over researched topics
- IJPM looks for
 - Mainly empirical papers, qualitative or quantitative, with rigor AND practical implications
 - Review papers, that bring forward a theoretical contribution
 - Conceptual papers from leading people in the particular topic
 - A typical IJPM paper is 8-10.000 words upon submission
- IJPM does not publish
 - Mathematical method application and demonstrations
 - Education papers
